

Interface Observation Memorandum: Movement and Recognition

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A memorandum asking observers to record whether a movement could be recognized as a response. It records travel and visible outcome but does not yet include familiarity, repeatability or ordinary-use confidence.

PROVENANCE

Maintained with the first Button & Interface working papers after the 1997 response-recognition study.

WHY PRESERVED

Preserves an early, incomplete distinction between movement and response before learned familiarity entered the method.
