

PCP Revision Notice: Equivalent Position

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A two-page circular stating that a nearby position may alter approach, access envelope or return path. The notice asks reviewers to describe what remained continuous rather than merely record a distance.

PROVENANCE

Issued by the Continuity Review Council after repeated field notes used nearby and equivalent as interchangeable terms.

WHY PRESERVED

The earliest surviving notice that frames equivalence as a continuity determination rather than a distance measure.
